# NOTIFICATION Home Department Sachivalaya, Gandhinagar. Dated the 11<sup>th</sup> March,2016.

Gujarat Police Act, 1951. No.GG/GUJ/ 26/2016/MHK/102013/3314/C:- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom.XXII of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector (Unarmed), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department, namely:-

- These rules may be called the Assistant Sub-Inspector (Unarmed), Class III, Recruitment Rules, 2016.
- Appointment to the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector (Unarmed), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department shall be made either,
  - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who,
    - in the cadre of Head Constable (Unarmed), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department,
    - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;
    - (iii) have fulfilled the minimum requisite standards of physical efficiency test, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time in this behalf:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and

that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of the period of not less than two- thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

- (b) by direct selection.
- 3. Appointment by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 2:1, respectively.
- 4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,
  - (a) not be less than 21 years of age and not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and Women: Provided further that upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided also that, the upper age limit may also be relaxed to the extent of three years in favour of a candidate who is working as a Constable, Class III or Head Constable, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department;

### (b) possess -

(i) a Bachelors' degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institution recognised by the Government or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess an equivalent qualification recognised as such by the Government;

- (ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
- (iii) the minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in Annexure-A appended to these rules.
- (iv) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
- (v) valid Heavy/light motor vehicle driving license within stipulated period of service on contractual basis.

Provided that preference may be given to a candidate who possesses "C" level Certificate of National Cadet Crops.

- 5. The provisions of rule 9 A of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
- 6. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, require to undergo police training and pass the post training examination in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 7. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall, after regular appointment, require to pass the departmental examination in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

- 8. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government.
