No. GG/58/MTS/102011/1140/V: In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom.XXII of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Police Inspector (Motor Transport), Class II, in the Gujarat Police Service, namely:

- 1. These rules may be called the Police Inspector (Motor Transport), Class II, in the Gujarat Police Service Recruitment Rules, 2018.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Police Inspector (Motor Transport), Class II, in the Gujarat Police Service, shall be made either,-
- (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
- (i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Police sub-Inspector (Motor Transport), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department, in the Motor Transport Division;
- (ii) have passed the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government;
- (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006, and;
- (iv) possess valid motor driving license of heavy goods vehicles or heavy passenger vehicles;

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or;

(b) by direct selection.

- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
- (a) not be more than 38 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favor of a candidate who is already in the service of Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classifications and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and in favor of women in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided also that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned; (b) possess a Bachelor's degree in Automobiles Engineering / Technology or Mechanical Engineering / Technology obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;

- (c) (i) have about three years' experience on the post not below the rank of Assistant sub-Inspector (Motor Transport), Class III, in the subordinate service of Gujarat Police Department or;
- (ii) have about three years' combined or separate experience in repair or maintenance of motor vehicles in the field of Military Workshop/Gujarat State Road Transport Corporation/Gujarat State Regional Transport Service (R.T.O.)/Local Body Transport Service Workshop/Authorised Service Center for four wheelers or in Authorised Service Center for Commercial Vehicles (Heavy Motor Vehicles), on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Assistant sub Inspector (MT), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Gujarat Police Department;
- (d) the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix annexed to these rules;
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both;
- (f) possess valid motor driving licence of heavy goods vehicles or heavy passenger vehicles.

- 4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo departmental training of three months and field training of nine months under the supervision of the Director General or Inspector General of Police (Technical Services).
- 7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both, in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 8. The candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 10. Where in respect of any matter regarding service conditions of the Police Inspector (Motor Transport), Class II for which specific provision is not made either in Act or in these rules, the following rules as amended from time to time which are applicable to the employees of the corresponding class of Government of Gujarat, shall, *mutatis-mutandis*, apply to the Police Inspector (Motor Transport), Class II, to whom these rules are applicable namely:-
- 1. The Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
- 2. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 2002.
- 3. The Gujarat Civil Services (Additions to Pay) Rules, 2002.
- 4. The Gujarat Civil Services (General Conditions of Service) Rules, 2002.
- 5. The Gujarat Civil Services (Travelling Allowance) Rules, 2002.
- 6. The Gujarat Civil Services (Occupation of Government Residential Accommodation) Rules, 2002.
- 7. The Gujarat Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 2002.
- 8. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2002.
