Gujarat Police Act,1951.

No.GG-83/2022/SB.5/CSS/102012/GOI-117-SB.5:- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom. XXII of 1951) and in suppression of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Engine Driver, Class III, in the subordinate service, of the Police Department, namely: -

- 1. These rules may be called the Engine Driver, Class III, Recruitment Rules, 2022.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Engine Driver, Class III, in the subordinate service in the Police Department, shall be made either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person who possess 'good' benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within the zone of consideration as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 from amongst the persons who, -
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Oilman, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department;
 - (ii) have Engine Driver Class 2 Certificate Issued by Inland Water Ways Authority of India (IWAI) or Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) or State Maritime Board or any other agency/authority under the Inland Vessels Act, 1917 or rules made therein under; and
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub- clause (i) is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up a post by promotion of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may for reasons to be recorded in writing to promote such

person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i); or

- (b) by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose; or
- (c) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working in the respective cadre of Engine Driver or any equivalent in the Indian Navy or Indian Coast Guard or the State Maritime Board and who possess the educational qualification and certificate as prescribed in clauses (b) and (c) of rule 3, for direct selection.
- 3 To be eligible for appointment by direct selection on the basis of . the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose, to the post mentioned in clause (a) of rule 2, candidate shall, -
- (a) not be less than 21 years of age and not more than 38 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates belonging to Schedule Castes, Schedule Tribes, Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and Economically Weaker Sections and in favour of women in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

(b) have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination from Secondary and / or Higher Secondary Education Board or possess an equivalent qualification as recognised by the Government;

- (c) have Engine Driver Class 2 Certificate Issued by Inland Water Ways Authority of India (IWAI) or Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) or State Maritime Board or any other agency/authority under Inland Vessels Act, 1917 or rules made there under;
- (d) have minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in Appendix A appended to these rules; and
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
- 4. The candidate selected by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose, shall be appointed on contractual basis in accordance with and on such terms and condition as prescribed by the Government from time to time.
- 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination shall be given, after completion of contractual period, the pay scale prescribed for the concerned post on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis.
- 6. The candidate selected by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis or within a period of two years thereafter, be required to pass the qualifying examination for Computer Knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 7. The candidate appointed by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 8. The candidate appointed by direct selection on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose, shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

- 1) The Candidate having any of following physical defects shall be considered physically unfit: Knock Knee, Pigeon Chest, Squint Eye, Flat Feet, Varicose Veins, Hammer Toes, Fractured Limb, Decayed Teeth and Communicable Skin Disease.
- 2) The medical officer shall, examine the candidate and issue the certificate of fitness taking into consideration the physical standards as mentioned above and also certify for the following parameters namely: -

SHAPEI Means

- S Psychological
- H Hearing
- A Appendage
- P Physical capacity for normal work
- E Eye sight
- I Means fit in all respect to perform normal

professional functions under each of the above mentioned heads:

Provided that the candidate with colour blindness defect shall be considered unfit for appointment.

(c) The candidate shall be free from surgical deformities like knock-knees, flat-foot and shall not have a past history of fits or psychiatric ailments, varicose vein, etc.
